rees of Hope was founded by a survivor with the goal of helping women heal from abuse. In 2006, the journey started in a living room with just five women. Over the years, the organization has significantly expanded with numerous healing groups for women and added various programs that serve men, teen girls, and teen boys. This diversification has enabled Trees of Hope to serve more people. The organization has reached over 5,500 individuals through its prevention and healing programs. Studies show that the majority of victims were abused by someone they knew, loved, and trusted. Trees of Hope fights this silent epidemic by following a two-fold organizational model of prevention and healing.

For prevention, Trees of Hope works to protect future generations through an age-appropriate educational curriculum and conducts prevention workshops for adults and caregivers. In these workshops, participants gain crucial knowledge about abuse, including the different ways it can happen, how to identify the grooming process, various symptoms of abuse, the link between abuse and pornography, and how to initiate honest conversations with children. They also learn how to support a victim through healing.

Our healing programs aim to walk alongside those affected by abuse by offering healing support groups, individual studies, and online studies. There should not be any hurdle or reason a victim can't find healing through Trees of Hope's unique curriculums designed for specific needs, genders, and ages.


### **OUR PREVENTION PROGRAMS**
